

## CV Ulu Braun

Ulu Braun was born 1976 in Schongau, Germany. He works and lives in Berlin (D) and Lieksa (Fi). Between 1996 and 2005 he studied painting and experimental film at the University of Applied Arts in Vienna and the Filmuniversity Babelsberg. 2008 he received a DAAD-Fellowship at the Academy of Fine Arts, Helsinki. Ulu Braun has been using the medium of video to explore the field between the visual arts and auteur cinema since 1998. He is one of the key figures who have transferred painting into video art and have played a significant role in defining and further developing the genre of video collage.
